# **Understanding Culture**

#### Greetings and customs around the world

There are many ways of greeting in the world, such as saying "hello" accompanied by shaking hands, kissing, hugging, or bowing. People in different countries follow different customs of greeting.

In modern China, people often shake hands when meeting for the first time.

In the USA, people may shake hands after greeting. A smile and a "hello" will do just fine.

The British often simply say "hello" when friends meet. Usually, they only shake hands when meeting someone for the first time.

The French shake hands with their friends and kiss them on both cheeks, both upon meeting and leaving.

In Japan, the common greeting is to **bow** when people greet someone, **as opposed to** giving a **casual** handshake or a hug.

In Russia, the typical greeting is a very firm handshake.



# **Understanding Culture**

#### Various clubs in Chinese and American high schools

There is a wide variety of clubs in both Chinese high schools and American high schools, and the clubs are run by the students themselves. Students create the clubs, write **mission statements**, develop goals, promote membership, hold meetings, and organise events.

In Chinese high schools, there are fun, diverse, highly-active clubs such as **service-oriented** clubs like **environmental protection club** and recycling club, interest-type clubs like **orchestra club**, **Chinese calligraphy club**, and **scholarly-type** clubs such as science clubs.

In American high schools, taking part in activities organised by clubs is a great way for students to find their high school social community. There are hobby clubs such as outdoor activity club and anime club, charity service clubs, saving endangered species club, career interest clubs such as future business leaders club, STEM club, model United Nations and mock trial club.
